

TOLOFONA CAMPING CENTER, OPERATION RULES

**Running by “Aris Konstantoglou” Cultural Society
(a non –profit society, judge of First Instance Court No-4686/2007)**

Article 1- AIM

1. The mission of our Tolofona Camp Centre (**there in after T.C.C**) is to support and implement outdoor living among children, young people and adults, who wish to come in contact with nature safely.
2. In particular the goal of **T.C.C** is to facilitate educational and outdoor activities, camping as well as instilling environmental awareness in the Greek Scout Association (**G.S.A**) and Greek Guiding Association (**G.G.A**) and to other organizations, institutions and schools whose presence and activities comply with the principles of G.S.A.

Article 2- GENERAL INFORMATION

The T.C.C spreads to over than 4.257 sq. m. with an overall barbed wire fencing, is located in a region Northeast of Tolofona village in the Municipality of Dorida, 200 Km from Athens, lying 3Km away from Eratini beach.

The camping is in the property of the **Cultural Society of Vironas “Aris Konstantoglou”** based in 23 Konstantilieri Street, in Vironas Municipality, Attiki, and Post code 16231.

Article 3 - T.C.C DESCRIPTION

1. Building premises

The T.C.C consists of building premises in uniform wooden structure, in harmony with the surrounding, which are:

a. A house with:

- * 1 bedroom with 3 bunk beds (for 6 persons)
- * 1 bedroom with 1 bunk bed (for 2 persons)
- * 1 entrance hall with 2 bunk beds, as well as 2 single beds (for 6 persons)
- * a large roofed terrace with 3 booths for 24 people and 4 benches
All around the terrace there is a plastic contraptions for protection against cold.
- * Mattresses, pillows, blankets and sheets for all beds
- * two wood heaters inside and in roofed terrace outside respectively
- * enough fire extinguishers which cover the above areas.

b. A Kitchen with:

- * built-in cupboards
- * a sink
- * 3 propane burners
- * a large propane burner (torch)
- * a professional extractor
- * a fridge freezer
- * a free standing freezer of 200 lt
- * all cooking and serving equipment
- * enough provisions of long duration.

c. A storage-room with:

Camping equipment which are at the campers' disposal if needed

d. Personal hygiene-room with:

- * 2 European tubs
- * 2 floor tubs (military style)
- * 2 shower units
- * 6 basins with mirrors
- * Pharmacy cabinet and First Aid Kit

Note: The kitchen and the personal hygiene spaces are connected with a solar heater. All premises a, b, c, d provide full electrical facilities.

2. Surroundings

Among the surrounding area lay the following buildings and facilities which will be gradually extended in accordance with the campers' needs.

a. A large wooden Entrance Gate (with observatory) of iron structure. By the gate there is a current meter of direct electricity as well as a fire-hydrant with housed fire-hose.

b. A Flagpole (protected by lightning rod). The Greek flag should be in the center and/ or at the highest point.

Only official and acknowledged flags or signs by G.S.A are allowed to be hosted alongside (port or starboard) of the Greek flag.

Under no circumstances they should provoke or offend our national flag or common emotion.

c. An Oratory

d. A gathering place and fire point (under surveillance)

Part of the outdoor place is covered by sun shade and also there are 3 awnings during the summer to facilitate various activities.

e. A large kiosk with benches for 20 people for resting, relaxing and savoring the view to the sea.

- f. **A camping place**, protected from the North winds by wind break and by a shady –flap for the summer period.
- g. **A sheltered place for equipment** washing up and two showers besides it.
- h. **A sheltered built oven and grill.**
- i. **Approximately 420 plants**, trees, bushes, cypresses, blueberries e.t.c. with automatic watering system.
- j. **Other installations.** The camping is equipped with an electric installation and tap-water system provided by the municipality, a no drinking water tank of 3 tones capacity (in case of outage) and 3 fire stations (barrels with water, buckets, axes and shovels), 1 fire-hydrant, 2 generators of 750 & 2500 W, 4 trash bins and 2 announcement boards.

Article 4- SUPERVISOR- ADMINISTRATOR

As Supervisor-Administrator of the T.C.C is to be appointed a member of Society through a unanimous decision taken by the Society’s Administrative Committee. She/he is referred to the Society’s Administrative Committee and is responsible for the T.C.C rightful and excellent state and function.

She/he is obliged to report to the Society’s Administrative Committee any problem, damage or destruction done to the premises, equipment and materials of the T.C.C. She/he takes also care by signing the relevant Protocol by the camp-master prior the beginning and end of camp period.

Article 5 - ALLOTMENT- USE- DUES

1. Entitled to using the T.C.C. are all members of our Society and their families, all parts of 1st Scout troop of Vironas , all Scout parts of the G.S.A and the G.G.A as well as various Children Groups or Organizations and youth and schools who share the same principles, aim and method system of scouting.
2. The use of T.C.C is **“Free of Charge”**. The campers should replace materials and resources used, such as gas, oil, petrol, firewood, cleaning and personal care equipment. They are also obliged to pay their exact water and electricity consumption together with the disposal of their garbage cost.
3. Prior to use , campers should pay a guarantee fee defined by the Administrative Committee which is refunded on their departure, provided there have been no damages or impairments to the place, installations, equipment and material.
Members of the Culture Society “Aris Konstantoglou” and members of the 1st Scout Troop of Vironas are exempted to paragraph 2 to this article as regard to the guarantee fee.

Article 6- APPLICATION- LICENSE

1. Use of the T.C.C. is granted with the Administrative Committee's decision following an application of the interested party and President's or any other member's proposal.

2. The camp Scoutmaster of Scouting Troop (Camp's master) is responsible for the safety and hygiene of the campers, while he/she possesses all qualities proposed by the Camping Regulations of G.S.A.

All members of scouting camp should be recorded in the inventory and insured as it is annually defined by the G.S.A. The same rules are applied to the members of G.G.A.

3. The Head of another group outside the G.S.A/G.G.A, as well the Scoutmaster of a foreign Scouting Troop should be 25-65years old and absolutely qualified to fill the post according to camping regulations.

She/he is the sole responsible for the safety of his/her campers and the region's hygiene, while he should confirm that all members are covered by private insurance with their contracts in force.

4. All responsible persons in camp should have a **"contingency -plan"** for their campers in case of adverse natural phenomena and destructions.

The "contingency plan" of TC.C can be found in our site or printed in the reception area of the camp. The Camp Master consults the "T.C.C contingency plan" and whether she/he accepts it as it is, or adopts his to the T.C.C contingency plan.

Article 7 – RESPONSIBILITIES IN T.C.C. UNDER THE GREEK LEGISLATION

The Administrative Committee of Cultural Society "Aris Konstantoglou" bear no responsibility for the safety, incidents or serious illnesses among young or adult campers.

The Scoutmaster of the Troop or the leader or the group in question is to be exclusively held responsible, as it is defined by article 6 paragraphs 2, 3 and 4. He/she is absolutely responsible to cater for his/her patient's medical costs.

The Society kindly provides only the premises, facilities and equipment of the camping **"Free of Charge"**.

Article 8 – USER'S OBLIGATION

1. The camp master/head who will make use of T.C.C. premises should have signed on both sides, before their arrival, a solemn statement according to Law 1599/1986 article 8, verified by a "Citizens Service Center" or "Police Station" complete with his personal

data and the appellation of the institution he/she represents along with the related text regarding his/her responsibilities towards the campers and the area.

2. On arriving at the camp, the above person receives from the camping Supervisor-Administrator the predetermined equipment and the materials internal control ensues and signs the relevant Protocol.

3. For any incident such as accident or illness of camper/s, damage or loss of equipment, damage of premises, building, trees or plants etc the Camp Master writes it down in the Log-Book and if she/he considers the incident very serious she/he must inform immediately the Supervisor-Administrator.

4. The camping's facilities and materials should be used properly and carefully in order to avoid damages. The responsible camp master should write any loss or damage of material, facility or building to the Log-Book and report it to the Supervisor-Administrator and bears the restoration or replacement costs.

4(a). In case of the T.C.C. severe destruction due to any cause, e.g. fire or car's collision into a building, irrespective of liability, the Camp master or Scoutmaster of the Troop part or the Society itself are to bear the restoration or replacement cost, during the time period of use.

4(b). All parties are exempted from any responsibility or coverage of cost in case of destructions caused to the camping by adverse weather conditions, namely: whirlwind, downpour, flood, and thunderbolt (although a lightning rod exists), and uncontrollable fire caused by neighboring incident.

5. Upon departure, all equipment and materials (as they are listed in the relevant Protocol) should be returned in a cleaned and ordinary fashion, while all garbage should be transferred to the area indicated by the camping Supervisor-Administrator.

6. All trees and plants of the camping must be protected. No one is entitled to uproot or cut any tree or plant, large or small. Planting is permitted only under permission given by the Supervisor-Administrator of the camp.

Article 9- OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES

The camp Supervisor-Administrator will announce activities outside the camping center such as local fests, explorations and excursions in the area. Also to serve the above needs of campers at T.C.C there are at their disposal the following:

An information booklet, a map of greater region and an Agro-Tourist –Guide of mountainous Dorida Region (book, 216 pages)

Article 10- IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REGULATION-FORMULATION

The present Regulation of operation, together with the three documents (Original Protocol Receipt-Delivery as well as the Solemn Statement of the camp leader or head and the Contingency Plan) are came into force on 24 February 2014 at 22:30 hours, after the unanimous Administrative Committee’s decision of the Vironas Cultural Society “Aris Konstantoglou” and it was reached at the Society’s Headquarters, on 23 D.Konstadilieri Street in Vironas Attiki as it was modified on 25 October 2016 .

Any modification or additions to the present Regulation and to the three (3) documents require the unanimous decision of the Administrative Committee and its formulation should be in the Greek and English language.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entire parts.
